1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital improvements; authorizing the issuance of state bonds;
1.3 appropriating money to design and construct improvements to the Mayo Civic
1.4 Center Complex in Rochester.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. MAYO CIVIC CENTER COMPLEX.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$37,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the
1.9 city of Rochester to design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation and expansion of
1.10 the Mayo Civic Center Complex and related infrastructure, including but not limited to
1.11 skyway access, lighting, parking, and landscaping.

1.12 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from
1.13 the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and
1.14 issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$37,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms,
1.15 and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and
1.16 by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
