1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; expanding medical assistance hospice service coverage
1.3 to include room and board; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625,
1.4 subdivision 22.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625, subdivision 22, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 22. Hospice care. Medical assistance covers hospice care services under Public
1.9 Law 99-272, section 9505, to the extent authorized by rule, except that:

1.10 (1) a recipient age 21 or under who elects to receive hospice services does not waive
1.11 coverage for services that are related to the treatment of the condition for which a diagnosis
1.12 of terminal illness has been made; and

1.13 (2) room and board expenses are covered for persons receiving hospice services in a
1.14 community-based setting, to the extent room and board expenses are not otherwise covered
1.15 under this chapter or chapter 256I.
