1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 179A.03, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. **Confidential employee.** "Confidential employee" means an employee
1.7 who as part of the employee's job duties:

1.8 (1) ~~has access to~~ is required to access and actually use labor relations information as
1.9 that term is defined in section 13.37, subdivision 1, paragraph (c); or

1.10 (2) actively participates in the meeting and negotiating on behalf of the public
1.11 employer.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
