1.7	governing body of a city or county shall issue to a sporting venue owner that is currently
1.8	licensed under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the on-sale of 3.2
1.9	percent malt liquor, a license for the on-sale of malt liquor and a license for the on-sale of
1.10	wine.
1.11	(b) All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this
1.12	section, apply to the issuance of a license under this section.
1.13	(c) For purposes of this section, a "sporting venue owner" means a person that owns and
