1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the Mississippi Crossings
1.3 Parking Area in the city of Champlin; authorizing the sale and issuance of state
1.4 bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. CHAMPLIN; MISSISSIPPI CROSSINGS PARKING AREA.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.9 Champlin to design, construct, and equip a parking area, including related site improvements
1.10 and infrastructure, for Mississippi Crossings. This appropriation includes money for charging
1.11 stations for electric vehicles, an ADA-compliant trail, an event space, an outdoor performance
1.12 area, and a municipal dock system.

1.13 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.14 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.15 the state in an amount up to \$1,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.16 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.17 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
