The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for capital improvements to
1.3 the public water system in the city of Medicine Lake; authorizing the sale and
1.4 issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. MEDICINE LAKE; PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Medicine Lake to predesign,
1.9 design, engineer, construct, furnish, and equip capital improvements to the Medicine Lake
1.10 public water system to meet Department of Health drinking water standards. This
1.11 appropriation includes construction and reconstruction of drinking water and wastewater
1.12 collection systems, associated street improvements, and improvements for hydrant fire
1.13 safety and suppression. This appropriation is exempt from the requirements under Minnesota
1.14 Statutes, section 16A.86, subdivision 4.

1.15 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.16 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.17 the state in an amount up to \$3,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.18 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.19 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.20 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
