 1.2 relating to public safety; enhancing penalties for certain repeat criminal sexual
 1.3 conduct offenders; amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 609.3451,
 1.4 subdivision 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 609.3451, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Felony.** A person is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced to imprisonment
 1.8 for not more than five years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both,
 1.9 if the person violates ~~subdivision 1, clause (2) this section,~~ after having been previously
 1.10 convicted of or adjudicated delinquent for violating ~~subdivision 1, clause (2) this section;~~
 1.11 ~~section~~ sections 609.342 to 609.345; 609.3453; 609.352; 617.23, subdivision 2, clause (1)
 1.12 or 3; 617.246; or 617.247; or a statute from another state in conformity with ~~subdivision 1,~~
 1.13 ~~clause (2), or section 617.23, subdivision 2, clause (1)~~ with any of those sections.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2013, and applies to crimes
 1.15 committed on or after that date.
