1.2 relating to human services; increasing payment rates for family planning services;

1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.764.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.764, is amended to read:

1.6 **256B.764 REIMBURSEMENT FOR FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES.**

1.7 (a) Effective for services rendered on or after July 1, 2007, payment rates for family

1.8 planning services shall be increased by 25 percent over the rates in effect June 30, 2007,

1.9 when these services are provided by a community clinic as defined in section 145.9268,

1.10 subdivision 1.

1.11 (b) Effective for services rendered on or after July 1, 2013, payment rates for family

1.12 planning services shall be increased by 20 percent over the rates in effect June 30, 2013,

1.13 when these services are provided by a community clinic as defined in section 145.9268,

1.14 subdivision 1. The commissioner shall adjust capitation rates to managed care and

1.15 county-based purchasing plans to reflect this increase, and shall require plans to pass on the

1.16 full amount of the rate increase to eligible community clinics, in the form of higher payment

1.17 rates for family planning services.

1.18 (c) Effective for services rendered on or after July 1, 2023, payment rates for family

1.19 planning services shall be increased by 30 percent over the rates in effect June 30, 2023,

1.20 when these services are provided by a community clinic as defined in section 145.9268,

1.21 subdivision 1. The commissioner shall adjust capitation rates to managed care and

1.22 county-based purchasing plans to reflect this increase, and shall require plans to pass on the

- 2.1 full amount of the rate increase to eligible community clinics in the form of higher payment
