A bill for an act

Section 1. ACCESSIBLE SPACE, INC.; APPROPRIATION.

\$1,150,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Accessible Space, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, for capital improvements of low-income accessible housing units located at 814 Iglehart Avenue, St. Paul, MN; 825 Selby Avenue, St. Paul, MN; 1370 Curve Crest Boulevard, Stillwater, MN; 135 to 154 Western Avenue S., St. Paul, MN; and 1074 Roselawn Avenue W., Roseville, MN.
