2.4 The proposed amendment must be submitted to the people at the 2012 general  
2.5 election. If approved, the amendment is effective for elections on or after June 30, 2013.

2.7 "Shall the Minnesota Constitution be amended effective June 30, 2013, to  
2.8 require that all in-person voters present an approved form of government-issued  
2.9 photographic identification at the time of voting; that those not voting in person provide  
2.10 government-issued proof of identity; that all voters be subject to substantially equivalent  
2.11 eligibility verification before a ballot is cast or counted; and that the state provide at no  
2.12 charge an approved photographic identification to eligible individuals?
