1.1 A bill for an act 1.2 relating to higher education; establishing performance goals; requiring reports. 1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. <u>PUBLIC POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS; PERFORMANCE</u> GOALS.

- (a) Five percent of any fiscal year 2017 general fund appropriation to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota is available after the Board of Regents demonstrates to the commissioner of management and budget that it has increased, by at least three percent, the number of undergraduate students who are enrolled in an average of 15 credits or more during the fall 2016 semester over the fall 2014 semester. In order to meet the performance goal under this paragraph, the board is requested to utilize, to the extent practical, structured scheduling to enable students to enroll in requisite courses that are offered in a coherent and connected block schedule.
- (b) Five percent of any fiscal year 2017 general fund appropriation to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is available after the Board of Trustees demonstrates to the commissioner of management and budget that it has increased, by at least three percent, the number of undergraduate students who are enrolled in an average of 15 credits or more during the fall 2016 semester over the fall 2014 semester. In order to meet the performance goal under this paragraph, the board shall utilize, to the extent practical, structured scheduling to enable students to enroll in requisite courses that are offered in a coherent and connected block schedule.
- (c) By August 1, 2015, the Board of Regents, the Board of Trustees, and the Minnesota Office of Higher Education must agree on specific numerical indicators and
