1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; WOMEN'S HEALTH EQUITY.

1.6 \$250,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2015 from the general fund to the

1.7 commissioner of health for a grant to a Somali-based health care organization located

- in Minnesota. The grant must be used to address health inequities experienced by first
- 1.9 generation Somali women. The services provided must be culturally specific in order to

1.10 improve Somali women's access to maternal health and preventive care; reduce infant

- 1.11 mortality; and increase health literacy. The grant recipient must use community-based
- 1.12 participatory research focusing on Somali women-centered programs, and must develop a
- 1.13 methodology to measure program effectiveness by achieving better health outcomes for
- 1.14 <u>Somali women. The grant recipient must report the program's measured outcomes to</u>
- 1.15 the commissioner by September 1, 2016.
