OFFICIAL STATUS

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to taxation; modifying allocation of motor vehicle lease sales tax revenue;
- 1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 297A.815, subdivision 3.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 297A.815, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 3. **Motor vehicle lease sales tax revenue.** (a) ~~For purposes of this subdivision,~~
- 1.7 ~~"net revenue" means an amount equal to the revenues, including interest and penalties,~~
- 1.8 ~~collected under this section, during the fiscal year; less \$32,000,000 in each fiscal year.~~
- 1.9 ~~(b)~~ On or before June 30 of each fiscal year, the commissioner of revenue shall estimate
- 1.10 the amount of ~~the net revenue~~ revenues, including interest and penalties, collected under
- 1.11 this section for the current fiscal year.
- 1.12 ~~(c)~~ (b) On or after July 1 of the subsequent fiscal year, the commissioner of management
- 1.13 and budget shall transfer the ~~net revenue as~~ revenues estimated in paragraph ~~(b)~~ (a) from
- 1.14 the general fund; as follows:
- 1.15 (1) ~~\$9,000,000 annually until January 1, 2015, and 50 percent annually thereafter~~ to the
- 1.16 county state-aid highway fund. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the
- 1.17 commissioner of transportation shall allocate the funds transferred under this clause to the
- 1.18 counties ~~in~~ immediately surrounding and adjacent to the metropolitan area, as defined in
- 1.19 section 473.121, subdivision 4, ~~excluding the counties of Hennepin and Ramsey~~, so that
- 1.20 each county shall receive of such amount the percentage that its population, as defined in
- 1.21 section 477A.011, subdivision 3, estimated or established by July 15 of the year prior to

- 2.1 the current calendar year, bears to the total population of the counties receiving funds under
- 2.2 this clause; and
- 2.3 (2) ~~the remainder~~ 50 percent to the greater Minnesota transit account.
- 2.4 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2017.
