1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the city of Hermantown  
 1.3 to develop a regional health and wellness center; authorizing the sale and  
 1.4 issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **HERMANTOWN; REGIONAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds  
 1.8 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the  
 1.9 city of Hermantown to predesign and design a health and wellness center to meet the  
 1.10 needs of the multigenerational population in the region. The facility will be located on the  
 1.11 Hermantown School District campus and may be operated in collaboration with the Young  
 1.12 Men's Christian Association. This appropriation does not require a local match.

1.13 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the  
 1.14 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue  
 1.15 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$250,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with  
 1.16 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the  
 1.17 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
