1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to early childhood programs; appropriating money to the Greater Twin
1.3 Cities United Way for a grant program to provide trauma-sensitive care in preschool
1.4 settings.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; GRANT FOR PROVIDING TRAUMA-SENSITIVE**
1.7 **CARE IN PRESCHOOL SETTINGS.**

1.8 Subdivision 1. Department of Education. The sum indicated in this section is
1.9 appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education in the fiscal year
1.10 designated.

1.11 Subd. 2. Grant for providing trauma-sensitive care in preschool settings. (a) For a
1.12 grant to the Greater Twin Cities United Way to support eligible programs for training
1.13 teachers and caregivers in providing trauma-sensitive care in preschool settings:

1.14 \$ 6,500,000 2024

1.15 (b) For purposes of this subdivision, "eligible programs" are nonprofit organizations
1.16 that have expertise in providing trauma-sensitive care in preschool settings.

1.17 (c) This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2027.
