1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to higher education; decreasing the assigned student responsibility for the

1.3 state grant program; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022,

1.4 section 136A.121, subdivision 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 136A.121, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Grant stipends.** The grant stipend shall be based on a sharing of responsibility

1.8 for covering the recognized cost of attendance by the applicant, the applicant's family, and

1.9 the government. The amount of a financial stipend must not exceed a grant applicant's

1.10 recognized cost of attendance, as defined in subdivision 6, after deducting the following:

1.11 (1) the assigned student responsibility of at least ~~50~~ 36 percent of the cost of attending

1.12 the institution of the applicant's choosing;

1.13 (2) the assigned family responsibility as defined in section 136A.101; and

1.14 (3) the amount of a federal Pell grant award for which the grant applicant is eligible.

1.15 The minimum financial stipend is \$100 per academic year.

1.16 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; STATE GRANT.**

1.17 \$..... in fiscal year 2024 and \$..... in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from the general

1.18 fund to the commissioner of the Office of Higher Education for the state grant program

1.19 under Minnesota Statutes, section 136A.121.
