1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.4914, subdivision 6d, is amended to

1.7 Subd. 6d. **Payment for customized living.** (a) The payment methodology for customized

1.8 living and 24-hour customized living must be the customized living tool. The commissioner

1.9 shall revise the customized living tool to reflect the services and activities unique to

1.10 disability-related recipient needs and adjust for regional differences in the cost of providing

1.11 services.

1.12 ~~(b) The rate adjustments described in section 256S.205 do not apply to rates paid under~~

1.14 ~~(e)~~ (b) Customized living and 24-hour customized living rates determined under this

1.15 section shall not include more than 24 hours of support in a daily unit.

1.16 ~~(d)~~ (c) The commissioner shall establish the following acuity-based customized living

1.17 tool input limits, based on case mix, for customized living and 24-hour customized living

1.18 rates determined under this section:

1.19 (1) no more than two hours of mental health management per day for people assessed

1.20 for case mixes A, D, and G;

1.21 (2) no more than four hours of activities of daily living assistance per day for people

1.22 assessed for case mix B; and

- 2.1 (3) no more than six hours of activities of daily living assistance per day for people
- 2.2 assessed for case mix D.
