OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for road construction to replace
1.3 former highway frontage roads in Mendota and Mendota Heights; authorizing the
1.4 sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **ROAD CONSTRUCTION; MENDOTA AND MENDOTA HEIGHTS.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,386,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.9 Mendota Heights to improve or replace the following roads within the city of Mendota
1.10 Heights: Center Point Curve, between Lexington Avenue and Lemay Lake Road; Carmen
1.11 Lane and the east-west portion of Crown Point Drive to its intersection with Trunk Highway
1.12 110; Dakota Drive, from Lexington Avenue to its easterly terminus; Waters Drive, from
1.13 Trunk Highway 55 to its northerly terminus; and Victoria Curve, from Lexington Avenue
1.14 to Trunk Highway 13.

1.15 Subd. 2. **Appropriation.** \$96,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the
1.16 commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of Mendota
1.17 to improve or replace the portions of Victoria Curve between Lexington Avenue and Trunk
1.18 Highway 13 and Center Point Curve between Lexington Avenue and Lemay Lake Road
1.19 that lie within the city of Mendota.

1.20 Subd. 3. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.21 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.22 the state in an amount up to \$1,482,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
