- 1.2 relating to education; making changes to school district board meetings and charter
- 1.3 school board meetings; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, sections 123B.09,
- 1.4 subdivision 6; 124E.07, subdivision 8.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 123B.09, subdivision 6, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 6. **Meetings.** (a) A majority of the voting members of the board shall constitute
- 1.8 a quorum. No contract shall be made or authorized, except at a regular meeting of the board
- 1.9 or at a special meeting at which all members are present or of which all members have had
- 1.10 notice. Special meetings may be called by the chair or clerk or any three members upon
- 1.11 notice mailed to each member at least three days prior thereto.
- 1.12 (b) The board must not require a person providing testimony at a board meeting to
- 1.13 publicly disclose the person's address or other contact information.
- 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2022.
- 1.15 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 124E.07, subdivision 8, is amended to read:
- 1.16 Subd. 8. **Meetings and information.** (a) Board of director meetings must comply with
- 1.17 chapter 13D governing open meetings.
- 1.18 (b) A charter school shall publish and maintain on the school's official website: (1) the
- 1.19 meeting minutes of the board of directors and of members and committees having
- 1.20 board-delegated authority, for at least 365 days from the date of publication; (2) directory
- 1.21 information for the board of directors and for the members of committees having

2.1 board-delegated authority; and (3) identifying and contact information for the school's
2.2 authorizer.

2.3 (c) A charter school must include identifying and contact information for the school's
2.4 authorizer in other school materials it makes available to the public.

2.5 (d) A board of directors must not require a person providing testimony at a board meeting
2.6 to publicly disclose the person's address or other contact information.

2.7 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2022.
