BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 340A.412, subdivision 14, is amended to 1.5 read: 16 Subd. 14. Exclusive liquor stores. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, 1.7 an exclusive liquor store may sell only the following items: 1.8 (1) alcoholic beverages; 1.9 (2) tobacco products; 1.10 (3) ice; 1.11 (4) beverages, either liquid or powder, specifically designated for mixing with intoxicating 1.12 liquor; 1.13 (5) soft drinks; 1.14 (6) liqueur-filled candies; 1.15 (7) meat-based food products that contain 1/20 of one percent alcohol by volume; 1.16 (7) (8) other food products that contain more than one-half of one percent alcohol by 1.17 volume; 1.18 (8) (9) cork extraction devices; 1.19 (9) (10) books and videos on the use of alcoholic beverages; 1.20

- (11) (12) multiple-use bags designed to carry purchased items;
- 2.4 (12) (13) devices designed to ensure safe storage and monitoring of alcohol in the home, 2.5 to prevent access by underage drinkers;
- (13) (14) home brewing equipment; and

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- 2.7 (14) (15) clothing marked with the specific name, brand, or identifying logo of the exclusive liquor store, and bearing no other name, brand, or identifying logo.
- 2.9 (b) An exclusive liquor store that has an on-sale, or combination on-sale and off-sale license may sell food for on-premise consumption when authorized by the municipality issuing the license.
- 2.12 (c) An exclusive liquor store may offer live or recorded entertainment.
