- 1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing municipalities to allow off-sales on Sundays;
- 1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 340A.504, subdivision 4.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 340A.504, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 4. **Intoxicating liquor; off-sale.** (a) No sale of intoxicating liquor may be made
- 1.7 by an off-sale licensee:
- 1.8 (1) on Sundays;
- 1.9 (2) before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m. on Monday through Saturday;
- 1.10 (3) on Thanksgiving Day;
- 1.11 (4) on Christmas Day, December 25; or
- 1.12 (5) after 8:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve, December 24.
- 1.13 (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a municipality may authorize off-sale licensees or a
- 1.14 municipal liquor store under its jurisdiction to make off-sales of intoxicating liquor on any
- 1.15 day, provided that no sale may be made before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.
- 1.16 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**
- 1.17 Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
