1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to campaign expenditures; prohibiting entities or organizations that receive

1.3 state funding from making campaign expenditures or otherwise expending money

1.4 for any political purpose; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,

1.5 chapter 211B.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **[211B.125] PUBLICLY FUNDED ORGANIZATIONS; CAMPAIGN**

1.8 **EXPENDITURES PROHIBITED.**

1.9 An entity or organization, including any nonprofit organization, that receives state

1.10 funding may not make a campaign expenditure or otherwise expend money for any political

1.11 purpose. As used in this section, "state funding" includes receipt of public funds through a

1.12 direct appropriation or a legislatively named, competitive, or other form of grant.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2024.
