AVIAN INFLUENZA PREVENTION PROGRAM. 1.5 (a) The commissioner of agriculture may award grants to poultry producers to install 1.6 avian influenza prevention measures to prevent transmission of avian influenza from wild 1.7 birds to domestic poultry. The commissioner may establish a cap on the amount of grant 1.8 1.9 money that a recipient is eligible to receive annually. (b) To be eligible for a grant under this section, a poultry producer must raise poultry 1.10 within Minnesota. Poultry producers must use grant money to reimburse themselves for the 1.11 cost of preventing the spread of avian influenza during operations in Minnesota. 1.12 (c) A grant applicant must document a cost-share of 20 percent for activities covered 1.13 by a grant under this program.
