1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 15A.0815, subdivision 2, is

1.7 amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 2. **Agency head salaries.** The salary for a position listed in this subdivision shall

1.9 be determined by the Compensation Council under section 15A.082. The commissioner of

1.10 management and budget must publish the salaries on the department's website. This

1.11 subdivision applies to the following positions:

- 1.13 Commissioner of agriculture;
- 1.14 Commissioner of education;
- 1.15 Commissioner of children, youth, and families;
- 1.16 Commissioner of commerce;

- 2.2 Commissioner of human rights;

- 2.7 Commissioner, Pollution Control Agency;

3.2 **246C.04 TRANSFER OF DUTIES.**

3.3 (a) Section 15.039 applies to the transfer of duties required by this chapter.

3.4 (b) The commissioner of administration, with the governor's approval, shall issue  
3.5 reorganization orders under section 16B.37 as necessary to carry out the transfer of duties  
3.6 required by section 246C.03. The provision of section 16B.37, subdivision 1, stating that  
3.7 transfers under section 16B.37 may only be to an agency that has existed for at least one  
3.8 year does not apply to transfers to an agency created by this chapter.

3.9 (c) The initial salary for the health systems chief executive officer of the Department of  
3.10 Direct Care and Treatment is the same as the salary for the health systems chief executive  
3.11 officer of direct care and treatment at the Department of Human Services immediately before  
3.12 July 1, 2024.

3.13 (d) The Compensation Council shall establish the salary in the Compensation Council's  
3.14 first report issued after the establishment of the Department of Direct Care and Treatment.

3.15 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 342.02, subdivision 6, is amended  
3.16 to read:

3.17 Subd. 6. **Director.** (a) The governor shall appoint a director of the office with the advice  
3.18 and consent of the senate. The director must be in the unclassified service and must serve  
3.19 at the pleasure of the governor.

3.20 (b) The salary of the director ~~must not exceed the salary limit established under section~~  
3.21 ~~15A.0815, subdivision 3~~ shall be established by the Compensation Council under section  
3.22 15A.082.
