PORT DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE. 1.5 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$40,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds 1.6 fund to the commissioner of transportation for purposes of the port development assistance 1.7 program under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 457A.
