No person operating or controlling a Class I or Class II railroad may allow the operation of a railroad train or locomotive in this state, used in connection with the movement of freight, without a crew composed of a minimum of two individuals, except as otherwise provided by Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 218, subpart B. A person violating this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and liable for a penalty of not less than \$250 nor more than \$1,000 for a first offense, not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 for a second offense, and not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 for a third or subsequent offense.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
