

CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR REGISTERING AND PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON TOWN ORDERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Town orders.

SECTION 1. That each and every Town Treasurer in the State shall keep a suitable book, to be provided at the expense of the town, in which he shall enter the town orders that he cannot pay for want of funds when presented to him for payment, which orders when presented shall be endorsed by such Treasurer, by putting upon the back of the same words "not paid, for want of funds," giving the date of such indorsement, signing the same as Town Treasurer, which orders when so indorsed shall bear interest from that date until paid.

SEC. 2. That all town orders shall be paid in the order that they are registered, out of the first moneys that come into the town treasurer's hands for such purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 115.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF A LEGISLATIVE MANUAL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to cause to be prepared and printed by the State printer, biennially hereafter, for the use of the Senate and House of Representatives, a book to be denominated "Legislative Manual," which shall contain the Constitution of the United States and of this State, Jefferson's Manual, Rules and Orders of the Senate and House, Joint Rules of the Senate and House, List of Senators and Members of the House and Employees of each House.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of State shall cause to be printed biennially, one thousand five hundred (1500) copies of such Manual, to be distributed as follows:
