

Change of county and township lines not to affect districts.

SEC. 3. That in the event of any change in the county and township lines affecting the districts provided in section two (2) of this act, the Senatorial and Representative districts shall not be affected thereby.

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT TO DECLARE THE COUNTY OF STEVENS TO BE AN ORGANIZED COUNTY, AND TO DECLARE LEGAL THE OFFICIAL ACTS AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND OTHER OFFICERS OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county of Stevens is hereby declared to be an organized county of this State, with all [the] due power belonging to organized counties under the laws of this State.

Official acts of county officers declared valid.

SEC. 2. All the official acts of the board of County Commissioners, County Auditor, Register of Deeds, County Treasurer, Clerk of the District Court, Judge of Probate, and other officers of said county, performed since the actual organization of said county in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one (1871), shall be deemed in all respects as valid and effectual as if the said county had been a duly organized county by act of the Legislature prior to end [of] said last mentioned year.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
