

one hundred and eighteen (118) of the general tax law, five hundred dollars (\$500).

Tree bounty.

Thirty-fourth—For payment of claims of persons who have complied with the act of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873) providing for a bounty for planting trees, five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

Fish.

Thirty-fifth—For payment of expenses of hatching and distributing fish, to be expended by the Fish Commissioners in accordance with the act providing for the propagation of food fishes, five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

Supreme court reports.

Thirty-sixth—For two hundred copies each of volumes twenty-nine (20) and thirty (30) of Supreme Court Reports, eight hundred dollars (\$800).

Military store keeper.

Thirty-seventh—For compensation of Military Store Keeper in addition to the amount now allowed by law, four hundred dollars (\$400).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 159.

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Salary of attorney general

SECTION 1. That the salary for the Attorney General for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and annually thereafter, shall be two thousand and five hundred dollars (\$2500).

SEC. 2. That subdivision five (5) of section ten (10) of chapter seven (7) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words two thousand (2000) and inserting the words twenty-five hundred (2500).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
