

county to save Chisago county from paying the same, and to reimburse the county of Crow Wing for expenses incurred and paid in caring for one Elof Holt who was a pauper and resident of said Chisago county.

How paid.

SEC. 2. That the State Auditor draw a warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of the county of Crow Wing for such amount as he may find due, not exceeding the amount above stated, and transmit the same to the Treasurer of Crow Wing county, who shall draw the money and place the same to the credit of Crow Wing county general fund.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE STANDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NORMAL SCHOOLS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES OF INSTITUTE TEACHERS THEREFROM.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriations for normal schools.

SECTION 1. That the sum of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000), in addition to the sum now allowed by law for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and annually thereafter, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money not otherwise appropriated for defraying the current expenses of the State Normal Schools, as follows:

For the State Normal School at Winona, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

For the State Normal School at Mankato, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

For the State Normal School at St. Cloud, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000); such money to be expended under the direction of the State Normal School Board, as provided by law.

SEC. 2. The State Normal School Board shall appoint one (1) teacher for each Normal School, especially qualified to give instruction in Teachers' Institutes. The salary of such teacher to be paid out of the money appropriated by section one (1) of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
