

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION THIRD (3d) OF SECTION SIXTY-FOUR (64) OF CHAPTER SIXTY-SIX (66) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT, (1878) RELATING TO SERVICE OF SUMMONS BY ADVERTISEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That subsection third (3d) of section sixty-four (64) of chapter sixty-six (66) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Amendment. THIRD (3d). When the defendant is not a resident of the State, but has property therein and the Court has jurisdiction of the subject of the action.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY (350) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three hundred and fifty (350) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 350. *Right of Withdrawal—Notice.* Any member of such company may withdraw therefrom at any time, by giving notice in writing to the President, or, in his absence to the Secretary thereof, and paying his share of all claims then existing against said company; and the Directors or a majority thereof shall have power to annul any policy by giving notice in writing to that effect to the holder thereof. And it shall also be the duty of the Secretary, whenever any member of such company shall withdraw from his membership therein, to notify every other member thereof of such withdrawal,
