## CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FOUR (104) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874,) APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE OFFICERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the twenty-third (23d) item of section one (1) of chapter one hundred [and] four (104) of the General Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), appropriating money for the payment of the salaries of the officers of the State government, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

23d. For salaries of the judges of the Supreme and District Courts seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$72,500).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTES IN RELATION TO CATTLE RUNNING AT LARGE IN TOWNS OF COKATO AND STOCKHOLM, IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Stock running at large.

Salaries of

state officers.

Section 1. That section thirty-seven (37), chapter nineteen (19), of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended by inserting after the words Fillmore county, in the second proviso, the words towns of Cokato and Stockholm, in Wright county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
