

CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT REGULATING THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTY OF FREEBORN. IN THE TENTH (10th) JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The general terms of the District Court in the county of Freeborn, in the Tenth (10th) Judicial District, shall be held each year as follows, instead of at the times heretofore fixed by law: On the second (2nd) Tuesday of January and the third (3d) Tuesday of May. And in case the business of said May term of court shall not be finished during the week previous to the time of holding said District Court in another county of said district, then the said May term shall be adjourned until the second (2nd) Tuesday of the July following for the transaction of such unfinished business; and *providing*, that at the time of such adjournment of said May term there shall be jury cases upon the calendar for trial undisposed of, the court may require the regular panel of petit jurors for said May term to attend at the adjourned term, or in its discretion direct a special venire to issue for that purpose.

Unfinished business.

SEC. 2. All actions, process, recognizances and proceedings of whatever nature had or done for, or returnable at any term of said court in said county, as heretofore fixed by law, shall be returnable to the next term for such county, as herein specified, and shall be as valid and binding in all respects as though no change had been made.

Actions, etc.,—
how returnable.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts heretofore existing inconsistent with this act, or relating to and providing for the holding of terms of the District Court in said county, are repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
