

CHAPTER 138.

AN ACT to detach certain territory therein described from independent school district number one (1) in Clay county, and apportioning its liabilities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all of townships one hundred and forty (140) and one hundred and forty-one (141) in range forty-eight (48), and the corresponding fractional townships in range forty-nine (49) all in Clay county, be and they are hereby detached from independent school district number one (1).

SEC. 2. That all of said township number one hundred and forty-one (141) and all of section one (1) of township one hundred and forty (140) shall constitute one (1) common school district, and shall be and become liable for, assume and pay to said independent school district number one (1) all money paid, or expense or obligation incurred in erecting school houses or maintaining schools in said territory.

SEC. 3. That all of said township one hundred and forty (140) except said section one (1) shall constitute a common school district, and shall be and become liable for and pay to said independent school district all money paid and obligations incurred in constructing school houses or maintaining schools therein. *Provided*, that said new districts shall have and hold all school houses now erected in their limits, and that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent a division of either of said common school districts in the manner provided by law.

SEC. 4. That the proper authorities of said county shall annually include in a general tax upon such detached territory, an amount sufficient to pay the debts and obligations mentioned in sections two (2) and three (3) of this act, and shall collect and pay the same over to the treasurer of said independent school district until the same is fully paid, principal and interest.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
