

CHAPTER 167.

AN ACT to legalize the organization of certain school districts in Lac Qui Parle county, and to legalize the official acts of the trustees of said school district.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That school districts numbered twenty-four (24), twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26) and twenty-seven (27), in Lac Qui Parle county, as the same are now constituted, are hereby declared to be organized school districts having all the rights, privileges and immunities of other organized school districts in this State, and all proceedings had in organizing said school districts, and all the official acts of said school districts, are hereby legalized and declared to be valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 168.

AN ACT to create and organize a special school district in the county of Jackson.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the territory hereinafter described, including the village of Jackson, shall be constituted one school district, and all schools organized therein in pursuance of this act shall, under the directions and regulation of the board of education, as hereinafter established, be public and free to all children residing within the limits thereof between the ages of five (5) and twenty-one (21) years inclusive, subject to such rules and limitations as the said board may establish.

SEC. 2. The subdivisions of land included in and constituting the said school district shall be as follows, to wit:

The southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twelve (12), all of section thirteen (13), the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) the east half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section fourteen (14), the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$), the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), the east half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section
