

CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT to authorize the clerk of the District Court of Blue Earth county to transcribe a portion of the records of his office, and to provide for the validity of such transcript.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. The clerk of the district court of Blue Earth county, in this State, is hereby authorized to transcribe into a suitable book to be provided for that purpose, the contents of the record-book of his office, known as judgment docket number one (1).

And such copy or transcript, when made and duly certified by said clerk, shall have the same legal status and validity for all purposes as the original thereof.

Said transcript shall be made under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said county, and for such compensation as they shall provide.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 203.

AN ACT to authorize the Hastings Union Industrial Association to distribute surplus funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the Hastings Union Industrial Association may distribute among its stockholders such funds as its board of directors may find not necessary for the purpose of carrying out the various objects of its organization.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force on and after its passage.
