

CHAPTER 322.

AN ACT to legalize the taxes that have been levied in the town of Two Rivers, Morrison county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all the taxes that have heretofore been levied in the town of Two Rivers, Morrison county, in this State, be and the same is hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER : 323.

AN ACT to legalize the organization of certain towns in Lac qui Parle county, and to legalize the official acts of the board of supervisors and all other officers of said towns.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the towns of Freeland, Hamlin, [McCusin,] Madison, Perry, Arena, River Side, Lac Qui Parle and Yellow Bank, in the county of Lac Qui Parle, as the same are now constituted, are hereby declared to be organized towns, having all the rights, privileges and immunities of other organized towns in this State, and all the proceedings had in organizing said towns, and all the official acts of the officers of each of said towns are hereby legalized and declared to be valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
