

CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to legalize certain roads in Carver county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all proceedings heretofore had by the county commissioners of Carver county, in laying out and establishing county roads in said county, are hereby legalized and declared to be valid, and such county roads are declared to be legally established highways of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 1, 1881.

CHAPTER 326.

AN ACT to legalize the election of the village of Murdock, Swift county, Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the election held on the eighth (8th) day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881) for the election of officers for the village of Murdock, in the county of Swift, be and the same is hereby legalized as fully, to all intents and purposes, as if the same was duly held.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved February 19, 1881.

CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to legalize certain taxes levied in Lac qui Parle county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the taxes levied by the county commissioners of Lac qui Parle county for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879) be and the same are hereby legalized and declared valid notwithstanding irregularities in said levy.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
