

## CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT to legalize certain acts of the board of county commissioner of the county of Murray and the election of commissioners had in said county, November second (2d). in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty (1880).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of county commissioners of the county of Murray, in re-districting said county and changing the number of commissioner districts therein from three (3) to five (5) at a session of said board held on the twentieth (20th) day of August, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty (1880), is hereby legalized and made valid to all intents and purposes the same as if such re-districting and change had been in all things authorized by and in pursuance of the statute in such case provided.

SEC. 2. That the five (5) commissioners chosen at the general election held in said county on the second (2d) day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty (1880), and now the acting county commissioners of said county, are hereby declared to be the legally elected commissioners of said county, and such election is hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 3. That all acts and proceedings had and taken by the commissioners mentioned in the preceding section in their official capacity as a board of commissioners or otherwise, are hereby legalized and made valid for all purposes whatsoever.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT to legalize the action of the county commissioners of the county of Marshall, in locating the county seat of said county at Warren.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the location of the county seat of the county of Marshall, in this State, at Warren by the county commissioners of said county be and the same is hereby confirmed and legalized.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
