

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to enable the trustees of "High Forest Seminary" to amend their articles of incorporation so that the board of trustees shall consist of fifteen (15) members instead of seven (7), as heretofore.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the trustees of "High Forest Seminary" be enabled to amend their articles of incorporation so that the board of trustees shall consist of fifteen (15) members instead of seven (7), as heretofore.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

AN ACT to provide for a plat commission for the county of Ramsey.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created a board in and for Ramsey county to be called the plat commission of Ramsey county, which shall consist of three (3) members who shall be freeholders and electors of said county, to be appointed by the chairman of the board of county commissioners of said county, and the president of the common council of the city of St. Paul, one of whom shall hold his office for one (1) year, one (1) for two (2) years, and one (1) for three (3) years and until their successors are appointed and qualified; said persons, before they enter upon the duties of their office, shall take an oath to faithfully discharge the duties of their office. Each of said persons shall serve on said board without compensation.

SEC. 2. That before any town plat or plat of any addition or subdivision of out-lots to any city in said county shall be accepted by the common council of such city or certified by the surveyor, the same shall be first submitted to said board who shall examine the same and the ground or territory covered by such plat, and for this purpose may employ a competent engineer and assistants,
