CHAPTER 391.

AN ACT to provide for the disposition of certain moneys in the possession of the county treasurer of Yellow Medicine county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The county treasurer of Yellow Medicine county is hereby authorized and required to pay over to the treasurers of the towns of Hazel Run and Friendship, respectively, in said county, all moneys now in his hands raised for road and bridge and other town purposes, which was raised by taxation of real or personal property within the limits of what now constitutes said towns, and which were levied and collected before said towns were organized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

CHAPTER 392.

AN ACT in relation to the salaries of treasurer and auditor of Blue Earth county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the county commissioners of Blue Earth county are hereby authorized to allow and pay to the treasurer and auditor of said county their respective salaries as ascertained by the provisions of chapter one hundred and twenty (120) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877) except that the limitations in said act shall not apply to said treasurer and auditor.

SEC. 2. The payments heretofore made to said treasurer and auditor in accordance with section one (1) of this act are hereby legalized.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
