

## CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR (4) OF CHAPTER SIX (6) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF LITTLE FALLS, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRISON.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section four (4) of chapter six (6) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, (1879) entitled an act to incorporate the village of Little Falls, in the county of Morrison, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit :

SEC. 2. *Provided, however,* that in lieu of electing " three " (3) trustees as provided in said chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139) of the general laws of the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875), the electors of said village of Little Falls shall elect *one trustee* only, and that the president, trustee and recorder shall constitute the village council; that in lieu of "electing one village constable" as provided in said chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139) of the general laws of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, (1875) the village council be and are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to appoint a village marshal who may hold said office until removed by said council, who shall receive such fees or per diem, or both as said council may ordain, and to appoint from time to time such deputy, village marshals as such council may deem necessary to preserve the peace and good order of said village, who shall hold such office during the time prescribed by said council and receive such per diem as said council shall direct. And such marshals and deputy marshals shall have all the powers, rights and authority of a village constable, and shall be subject and liable to the general laws pertaining to the powers and duties of village constables in this State.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
