

Warrants. SEC. 2. The State Auditor is authorized to draw warrants for the amounts herein appropriated, payable to said Archibald McElrath upon the return of the certificate issued by the Commissioner of the State Land Office, and upon such return the Commissioner of the State Land Office is authorized to cancel said sale.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR ENLARGING THE GROUNDS OF THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT MANKATO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

\$3,000 appropriated.

Warrants.

SECTION 1. That the sum of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to be expended by the State Normal School Board in the purchase of Block No. four (4) of Warren's Addition in the city of Mankato, and also that triangular piece of ground situate between said Block four (4) and the Normal School ground, for the purpose of enlarging the Normal School grounds at Mankato, the said money to be paid on warrants drawn by the President of the Normal School Board and countersigned by the Treasurer of the Normal School at Mankato, and that upon the presentation of such warrants to the State Auditor it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the State Treasurer for such sums not exceeding the sum of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars, as may be necessary for the purpose herein designated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
