

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE TWO (2), OF CHAPTER SIXTY-SIX (66), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO TIME OF THE COMMENCEMENT OF CIVIL ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That title two (2), of chapter sixty-six (66), of the General Statutes of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), relating to the time of commencing actions, be and the same is amended by adding to section twenty-five (25) of said title the following: That all the provisions of this title as to the time of the commencement of civil actions shall apply to municipal and all other corporations with like power and effect as the same applies to natural persons.

To apply to municipal and other corporations.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in power from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FORTY-NINE (49) OF CHAPTER SIXTY-SIX (66), OF GENERAL STATUTES OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO CIVIL ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section forty-nine (49) of chapter sixty-six (66) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), by adding at the end thereof the following proviso, to-wit: *Provided* that where defendants reside in different counties and appear and answer by different attorneys, the action, shall on motion, be transferred to the county agreed on by such defendants, or which is designated by the largest number of defendants who join in an answer.

Transfer of actions.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
