

estate or to the minor children represented by him, and may also release and tully discharge any land in this state from the lien of any such judgment or mortgage.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN (127) GENERAL LAWS A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and twenty-seven, (127), General Laws A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), an act in relation to the use of school houses in common school districts, shall apply to all Independent, Special, or free school Districts also.

Applies to independent school districts.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SEVEN (7) CHAPTER TWENTY-EIGHT (28), GENERAL STATUTES A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section seven (7) of chapter twenty-eight (28) of General Statutes A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended to read as follows: Nothing in this chapter shall extend to sales made by sheriffs, coroners, constables, collectors of taxes, or sales of personal property under and by virtue of chattel mortgages.

Limitation.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
