

commissioners under the general laws of this State, to post notices of the first election in said vilage, viz: J. B. Kennedy, J. M. Olson and A. F. Rabe, or a majority of them.

SEC. 3. That upon organization as directed in the general laws of this State, the said territory shall constitute the village of Nicollet, and shall thereupon be endowed with all the rights, powers, franchises and duties therein prescribed, or to be hereafter prescribed for organized villages in this State.

SEC. 4. Before any incorporation shall be had under this act, the same shall be voted upon and decided by ballot, by a majority of the legal voters of said territory, said election to be called upon notices by said commissioners or a majority of the same, as the election of the officers provided in chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139), of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875).

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF ROCKFORD IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is hereby set apart, for incorporation as a village, by the name of Rockford, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of section twenty-nine (29) and the east half of the northwest quarter of section twenty-nine (29) and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty-nine (29) and the southeast quarter of southeast quarter of section twenty (20), township one hundred and nineteen (119), of range twenty-four (24) in Wright and Hennepin counties.

SEC. 2. W. W. Park, C. C. Willcott and G. W. Florida are hereby designated to secure the incorporation of the said village.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
