

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 138.

AN ACT REGULATING THE HOLDING OF ELECTIONS AND MEETINGS OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF DULUTH.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all meetings and elections hereafter in the Independent school district of Duluth, for the purpose of electing officers of said district or for the purpose of raising or providing any money or funds for the use of said district, or the school therein, or for creating any debt, obligation or liability of said district; shall be called for, appointed, opened and begun at six (6) o'clock in the afternoon, and shall be held open and continued without adjournment or recess, for three (3) hours thereafter.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts and laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SIXTY-SIX (66), IN THE TOWN OF CANTON, FILLMORE COUNTY, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR (4), IN TOWN OF NEWBERG, IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twelve (12), in township one hundred and one (101), of range nine (9) west, is hereby detached from school district number sixty-six (66) in Fillmore county, and attached to and made part of school district number four (4), in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
