CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR BUILDING A BRIDGE ACROSS THE DES MOINES RIVER, IN COTTONWOOD COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of six hundred (\$600) dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys that shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, to reimburse the county of Cottonwood, for moneys expended in building a bridge across the Des Moines river in said county, on or near the section line between sections twenty-five (25) and thirty-six (36), in town one hundred and five (105), range thirty-six (36); Provided. The amount hereby appropriated shall not exceed one-half (½) of the cost of said bridge and approaches, and said bridge shall be forever free from toll, and be kept in repair and maintained by said Cottonwood county.

Sec. 2. That upon the completion of said bridge and approaches thereto, the board of county commissioners of said Cottonwood county, shall ascertain and officially report to the State auditor the cost thereof separately, and that the same are completed and ready for travel, and the State auditor shall thereupon draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the amount herebyappropriated in favor of the treasurer of said Cottonwood county and transmit the same to him, and the same shall be applied proportionately to

the payment of the cost of said approaches.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT TO APROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WAGON BRIDGE ACROSS THE INLET OF LITTLE KANDIYOHI LAKE, IN KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred (\$500) dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, to aid the town of Kandiyohi, in the county of Kandiyohi, in rebuilding

the wagon bridge across the inlet of Little Kandiyohi Lake, in section thirty-three (33), town one hundred and nineteen (119), of

range thirty four (34), in the county of Kandiyohi.

SEC. 2. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid to the treasurer of said town of Kandiyohi, upon the warrant of the State auditor, which warrant shall be issued upon the application of the board of supervisors of the said town of Kandiyohi.

SEC. 3. Said moneys so appropriated shall be expended under the direction of and by the board of supervisors aforesaid, for the purpose of rebuilding the bridge aforesaid, and for no other purpose

whatever.

Provided, That no moneys shall be paid or drawn by virtue of this act until the State anditor shall receive satisfactory evidence that the said bridge has been fully completed, and ready for travel, and that the amount of the appropriation hereby made has been actually expended thereon.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD BRIDGES IN CASS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars or so much thereof as may be required, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first money that shall come into the State treasury belonging to said fund, to build good and substantial bridges across the Gull River and Cullen creek, in said Cass county. Said bridges when erected to be and remain forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. Said bridges shall be built under the direction of the board of county commissioners of Crow Wing county, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid out of the State treasury until

the completion of the bridges above mentioned.

SEC. 3. Jonathan Chase, R. C. Leavitt and A. E. Horr, are hereby appointed a committee on the part of the State to view and examine the bridges as soon as completed and to examine all contracts, papers and accounts respecting their construction, and to fix and decide the cost thereof and to report to the State auditor, the sum said contractor or contractors shall be entitled to under the contracts, agreements or specifications relating to the construction of the bridges aforesaid.

Sec. 4. Any two (2) of said committee may act in the premises, and in case two (2) of said committee cannot be found or refuse
