

CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER THREE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (379), OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2), of chapter three hundred and seventy-nine (379), of the special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) be amended by striking out the word and numerals "thirty (30)," wherever they occur in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word and numerals ten (10).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 59.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTEEN (13) CHAPTER TWO (2) SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirteen (13) chapter two (2) Special Laws of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881), be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 13. Should a vacancy occur in any of the elective offices provided for in this act, the village council or the remaining members thereof shall fill the same by appointment. Any person appointed to fill a vacancy, shall hold his office and discharge the duties thereof until the next annual election, with the same rights and subject to the same liabilities as though he had been regularly elected.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
