

CHAPTER 136.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN (147) GENERAL LAWS A. D. EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), BEING AN ACT CREATING THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE TWELFTH (12TH) JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and forty-seven (147), General Laws eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) creating the office of district attorney for the twelfth (12th) judicial district, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after January first (1st) eighteen hundred and eighty-six (1886).

CHAPTER 137.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR STATE INSTITUTES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) in addition to the sum now allowed by law, be appropriated for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), and annually thereafter, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, for defraying the current expenses of state institutes under the direction of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

School to be closed during institute week.

SEC. 2. Any school that may be in session in a county at the time of holding a state institute for that county, shall be closed for one (1) week upon the requirement of the superintendent of the county for the purpose of allowing the teacher to attend the institute; and the teacher shall be allowed to make up [the time so lost, upon presenting to the clerk of] the district a certificate of the county superintendent attesting said teacher's attendance at the institute.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
